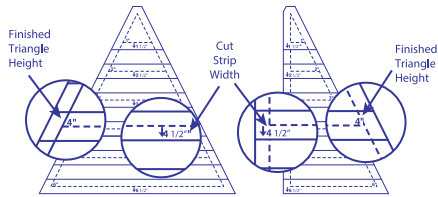
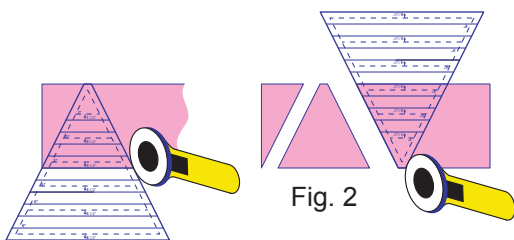


Directions for Tri Recs



1. **Cut Tri triangles:** Cut the appropriate strip width. Place the top edge of the tool along the top edge of the strip and align the bottom of the strip with the appropriate line on the tool. Cut on both sides of the tool. Fig. 1. Rotate the tool so it is pointing down; align with the strip edge and the cut edge and cut again. Fig. 2.



2. **Cut Recs triangles:** Cut the same size strip for the Recs triangles as you did for the Tri triangles. There are 2 Recs for each Tri. Place the strips right sides together to automatically cut both a right and a left triangle. Align the top of the tool with the top of the strip as shown. Cut as indicated. Trim off the "magic angle". This will make alignment for piecing a breeze. Figure 3. Rotate the tool so it is pointing down; align with the strip edge and the cut edge and cut again. Fig. 4.

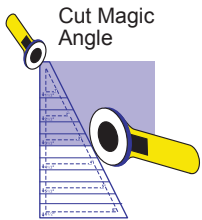

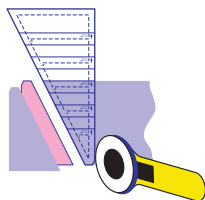

3. **Stitch Tri and Recs together:** With right sides together stitch one Recs triangle to the left side of the Tri triangle, aligning the "Magic Angle" with the bottom edge of the Tri triangle. Fig. 5. Press seam toward Recs triangle. Stitch the second Recs triangle to the right side of the Tri triangle, aligning the "Magic Angle" with the bottom edge of the Tri triangle, to complete the square. Fig. 6. Press seam toward the Recs triangle. Trim the "dog-ears".

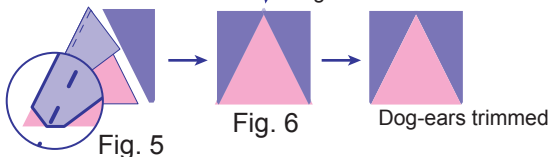

4. **Stitch Recs triangles together:** Place two Recs triangles right sides together, aligning the "Magic Angle" with the bottom edge of the Recs triangle. Fig. 7. Stitch and press toward the darker fabric.

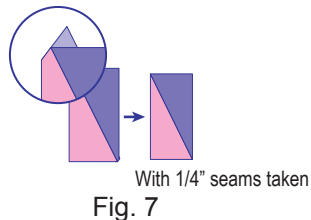
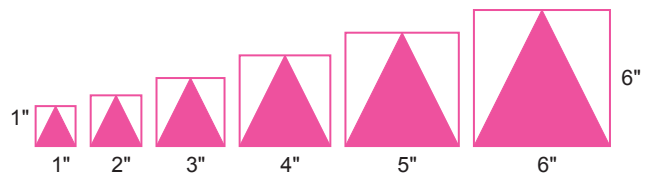
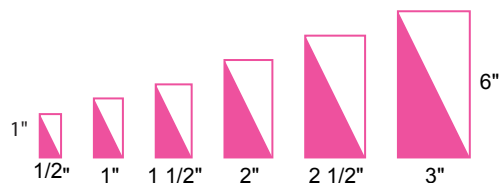
