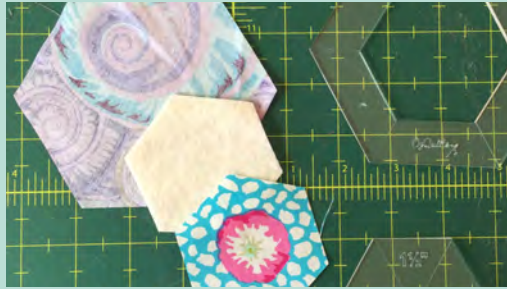


FRAMED HEXAGONS NESTED SET OF TEMPLATES



CUT

*Cut 1 large hexagon from fabric - the "frame"
Cut 1 small hexagon from fabric and batting.*



LAYER

- Large Hexagon wrong side up
 - Batting
 - Small Hexagon right side up
- Position inside your frame acrylic template*



PIN OR FUSE YOUR 3 LAYERS

Pin your layers together or press if using fusible batting



FOLD YOUR SEAM MAKE A FRAME

Fold the seam allowance over once to meet the small hexagon. Then fold the seam allowance again over the top of the small hexagon to create the frame.



PIN, CLIP AND/OR GLUE YOUR FRAME

Tip - fold over the seam allowance on alternate sides of the hexagon. Then go back and do the remaining three sides. I find this creates an easier, neater edge.



GLUE & STITCH

Your block is ready for stitching! Hand or machine stitch down the seam allowances. Join blocks together with ladder stitch.
